


RESIDENTIAL USE: LIFETIME/6 YEARS*

If the home is sold, the warranty reverts to fifteen years from the date of the installation and the second owner received coverage for the time remaining. Parts are warranted for 6 years from the date of manufacture or 5 years from the effective date, whichever is greater.

LIGHT DUTY COMMERCIAL USE: 10 YEARS/1 YEAR*

Apartments, condominiums, restrooms in office and commercial buildings, multifamily housing or any light duty commercial/industrial use – the tank is warranted for 10 years from the date of installation. Parts are warranted for 1 year from the date of manufacture.
